With a professional drumming career spanning thirty years, Liz has a diverse background of performance, teaching, presenting, facilitating, writing, and developing drumming programs and curricula. Her performances and teaching include a broad selection of drums including West African *djembe* and *dunun* drums, Afro-Cuban *conga*, and drum set. She is an adjunct instructor at Lake Tahoe Community College and a certified facilitator for DRUMBEAT, a program that engages participants, builds social skills, increases self-esteem and explores connections between making music together as a group and the development of healthy relationships.

Through her company Drumchik Productions, Liz offers a variety of children's educational programs and performances, adult classes and workshops, corporate/staff team-building workshops, and inspirational presentations. Her multi-media production *DURGA'S DRUM STORY* is appearing in theaters and art centers in California and Nevada. Liz is the founder and artistic director of *DEA Drum and Dance*, and performs regularly with this troupe.

Liz has been working with school-age youth since 2003. She has experience with students in grades K-12 and in developing meaningful, age-appropriate, fun curriculum and drumming activities. Liz continuously evaluates her programs and researches ways to ensure that they offer students an enriching art/musical experience and that they help the students with academic success.

Liz has authored to published books, *Djembe 101*, an instructional book with a DVD and play-along CD, and *Adventures of Durga*, *Messenger of the Drum*, a young reader's chapter book.
